"GOD IS HOPE" DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER

Our prayer this week focuses on God Who is *Hope*. He is the One Who can be our confidence, our trust, our expectation and our desire in this broken world.

It comes from our prayer verse: Romans 15:13 "May the God of *hope* fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with *hope* by the power of the Holy Spirit."
