## "GOD IS MERCIFUL" DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER

Our prayer this week focuses on God Who is *Merciful*. He is the One Who is full of *mercy*, kindness and compassion.

It comes from our Prayer Verse, I Peter 1:3-5 "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! *In His great mercy* He has given us new birth into a *living hope* through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can *never perish*, *spoil or fade*. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you, *who through faith are shielded by God's power* until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time!"

Our encouragement is that we can praise God, the Father of Jesus our Savior, for His great mercy for us. When He created us, it was through His boundless love and mercy in His heart that He designed us and brought us into being, uniquely creating each one to the task that is set before us. His mercy is never exhausted! It is new everyday for us. Let us pray that we recognize this, accept His gifts and honor and praise Him for them for He truly is a loving and merciful God. Let us pray:
