"GOD IS OUR ROCK" DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER

Our prayer this week focuses on God Who is our "*Rock*"! He is the One Who protects us from harm or danger, keeps watch over us and keeps us secure.

It comes from our Prayer Verse: Isaiah 26:3-4 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in You. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord, the Lord Himself, is the *Rock* eternal!"
