"GOD IS TRUSTWORTHY" DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER

Our prayer this week focuses on God Who is "*Trustworthy*". He is reliable, faithful, dependable and the only One Who is worthy of all our confidence.

It comes from our prayer verse: Proverbs 3:5 "*Trust* in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."

Our encouragement comes as we look at the writer and when he wrote it, and also why he wrote it. King Solomon was King of Israel and wrote this while he had all the wealth and pleasures of this world at his fingertips. He also had power, prestige and wisdom beyond any man before or after him that was given to Him by God. He was known as one of the greatest, wealthiest and wisest Kings in all of history, and there is no one that has ever been able to accomplish what he has since his birth. These are the things that mankind strive for, things that mankind tend to find their identity in, things that the world calls "Success" and put their trust in. And even though Solomon had all of this, he still wrote "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."
