## **"GOD IS WISE" DEVOTIONAL & PRAYER**

This week our prayer focuses on God Who is "*Wise*". He is the One Who has discernment, understanding and knowledge of all things.

It comes from our Prayer Verse: Proverbs 4:11 "I will guide you in the way of *wisdom* and I will lead you along straight paths."

Our encouragement from this verse comes from knowing God is True Wisdom and is willing to guide us in *His wisdom*. The One Who created all the universe and made every detail in it, from the galaxies to the smallest form of matter, is the only Wise One we should humbly seek each day. His *wisdom* is supernatural and beyond human comprehension.
